Camp Director - Robert Walkley

Coach Walkley has been a leader in the Rockland County soccer community since 1975 when he returned from his college playing days at Illinois where he was an all-American candidate. He holds a degree in Physical Education and an "A" license from the United States Soccer Federation (highest license attainable in America). Since 1987, Coach Walkley has frequently traveled to Holland to study the "Dutch Training Methods." Coach Walkley is currently coaching the Boys Varsity Soccer team at Suffern HS. They were ranked 2nd in NY State and 25 in the Nation with a 17-3-1 record this 2004 season. Before taking the Boys team over in 2003, he held the same position with the Suffern Girls team from 1999 - 2002, in which the 2000 team was a section champion. Prior to coming to Suffern, Coach Walkley led the Boys and girls Varsity teams at Albertus Magnus HS. The boy's team has a county championship and a Section 9 crown. They appeared in a state semi-final in 1981. During Coach Walkley's time with the girls, they were State Champions in 1994, winning the section crown 5 out of 6 years, with one regional crown. He was the NY State Coach of the year in 1994. For the past 8 years, Coach Walkley has been an Eastern New York O.D.P. Coach. He was appointed to the Region 1 boy's staff in 1992 and has been the Director of Coaching for ENYSSA North ODP since 2007.

Assistant Director - Brian Fitzpatrick

Coach Fitzpatrick is also a Certified Physical Education teacher and USSF Licensed coach. A former All County player of Coach Walkley's at Albertus he began his coaching career in 1995 as Coach Walkley's Assistant with the Albertus' Girls Team. In 1997 Coach Fitzpatrick became the Boys Varsity Coach at Albertus. Since taking over, the Albertus boys have won 6 League Championships and 3 straight Section 1 Championships in 2004, 2005 and 2006. In 2006 the Falcons became the first team in Rockland County history to win the New York State Boys Soccer Championship. Coach Fitzpatrick was named the Rockland County Coach of the Year in 2001, 2004 and 2006.
